2022Facts

The Sprout School served **152** children event while the pandemic continued, and **30** children graduated ready for kindergarten in 2022

13,219 calls were managed by **EmpowerNet**. This included inbound and outbound calls.

1785 calls were domestic violence/sexual violence calls

2,412 contacts were managed via our new text/chat feature

139 new individuals received emergency shelter for a total of **741** nights.

Even during a statewide eviction moratorium we were able to move

21 clients into permanent homes and **39** into temporary housing

92 individuals received employment navigation services

172 survivors received court advocacy last year.

235 survivors received community case management

14 new volunteers were trained through our **40** hour training session
